

UK undergraduate scholarships on offer

Kingston University, UK, is offering undergraduate scholarships for its courses starting September 2017. The scholarships are open to prospective full-time undergraduate Indian students in any subject area.

The London-based university

is a public research university and was founded in 1899.

The scholarships are competitive and will be awarded to the most deserving students on the basis of: academic merit; what you expect to gain from the course you are taking; and what you intend to do after completing the course. In order to apply, you must first hold an offer

(conditional or unconditional) of a place on an undergraduate course at Kingston University.

You will need a copy of your offer letter; an academic reference letter; a copy of your academic transcript/worksheet; and a copy of your academic IELTS or TOEFL result (where applicable) as some of the documents.

The application deadline is May 31, 2017. Two undergraduate scholarships worth £4,000 for the first year of study will be awarded.
